GUIDELINES:

1. Label all products; use only standard jar with two-piece jar tops.
2. Jellies should be entered in clear, smooth glass pint or jelly jars.
3. Pickles, relishes, fruits, vegetables may be in either pints or quarts.

3. “Dry” is defined as not more than 2% residual sugar.
4. Entries will be judged on appearance (clarity and color), aroma (fruit and floral)
